- Students eat at the tables. Not on the stage. Not on the radiators. Not outside. Everyone cleans up after themselves.
- Preschoolers and kindergarteners all eat together under the supervision of Pre-K and K lunch duty monitors.
They go outside only as a group and only under supervision.
They always stay together.
